- Excellent organisational and administrative skills
- Ability to prioritise and attention to detail
- Experience of supervising and working with a team
- Ability to remain calm in high-pressure situations
- Complying with all aspects of British Orienteering's Health & Safety Policy, Child Protection policy and Welfare arrangements.
- Current Driving Licence
- Be committed to supporting the prevention of doping behaviour and ensuring compliance with WADA code
